陳總經理：

對於國航集團的貢獻並長期致力葛蘭郡發展，特此褒揚。國航集團過去 20 多年來，一直擔任先鋒及主導地位，推動葛蘭郡及華盛頓州其他社區的商業發展。貴公司對地區經濟成長的遠見，及投入的時間與資源，實不容漠視。國航集團的市場研究及地區行銷報告，持續顯示，就業機會穩定增加，地區居民生活水準提高。國航集團對地區的基礎建設與相關設備，曾作巨額的財務投資。確信，國航集團將繼續支持葛蘭郡，創造就業機會與商機。

最近欣聞夢思湖大賣場零售業，創造約 20 名就業機會。此乃歸功於國航集團，提供適合其需要的最佳店面，得以擴充營業至中華盛頓州。此外，也獲悉，國航集團投資移民中心的一項專案計畫—夢思湖安養中心，自開始營業以來，已創造 60 名全職與半職工作機會，同時，第二期開發專案也開始進行。更高興聽到可口可樂公司現為貴公司倉儲的租戶，雇用約 11 名員工。

對貴公司近年來所完成的成功紀錄，期盼國航集團能繼續努力不懈，推展夢思湖與葛蘭郡的發展，協助建設地區的經濟。


I want to recognize ASPI Group's effort and long-term commitment in Grant County. The market studies and regional promotion of ASPI Group continues to provide steady increase in jobs and raises the standard of living of the local population. ASPI has made an enormous financial investment into the local development of infrastructure and facilities.
