Your involvement with past initiatives such as the Public/Private venture of the Boeing 7E7 project, the recruitment of Genie Industries and the expansion of Chemi Con Materials Corporation and the U.S. Department of Commerce EDA project at the North Gateway Center has resulted in a very valuable impact on our community.

I would like to specifically acknowledge the efforts of ASPI Group's Corporate Counsel, Kim Foster. Mr. Foster has been a key component of many of our highest profile projects including the proposal to Lockheed Martin on Spaceport Washington, the Boeing 787 project, General Dynamics, and the recruitment of Genie Industries.

We have come a long way to be where we are today. Recently, Grant County EDC completed a survey on one of our industrial recruitment companies - Genie Industries. We learned that their employee count increased from 200 people in 2002 to 535 employees as of 1st quarter 2006. That's 167% increase in three years. The total county impact of Genie is calculated to be 1,337 total project related jobs (both direct and indirect) with estimated \$41,450,000 total wages and benefits going to the economy of Grant County annually.

We also appreciate the financial support that ASPI Group has contributed to Grant County EDC in the past and appreciate the commitment that ASPI Group has made for funding in 2006. We look forward to ASPI Group's continued involvement in our efforts and, again, thank you for your dedication to the economic well being and continued growth of Grant County and our communities.
